MEMBER NOTICE

Due to recent Federal regulation changes, please be aware of the following policy updates, effective July 1, 2020.

Funds Availability Policy changes:

- The amount available for withdrawal for checks deposited not subject to next-day availability will increase from \$200 to \$225.
- The amount required to be made available for cash withdrawals from local and non-local checks will increase from \$400 to \$450.
- The amount available for withdrawal on exception holds for large deposits and new accounts not subject to next day availability will increase from \$5,000 to \$5,525.

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Disclosure changes:

- Point of Sale (Debit) transactions will be limited to (20) and/or \$3,000 per day.
- ATM transactions will be limited to (10) per day.
- Debit/ATM transactions will be limited to an aggregate of (25) per day.
- Person-to-Person transactions (Venmo, Square, Cash App, DoorDash, Uber, etc.) will be limited to (3) per day and (15) per week.
