- If your new love interest is asking for money or access to your finances before you have had a chance to build a relationship and trust
- If the person seems too good to be true or has over-the-top stories or a dramatic backstory.
- Finally, be cautious of someone who is reluctant to talk to you on the phone or meet in person.

If you have any doubts or suspicions, it's best to trust your instincts and end the relationship.
